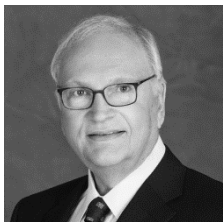

FEATURED SPEAKER:



Park Dietz, M.D., M.P.H., Ph.D.

Dr. Dietz created the world's first company devoted to workplace violence prevention (Threat Assessment Group, Inc., or "TAG," headquartered in Newport Beach, CA) and has led his team of mental health and former law enforcement professionals in successfully preventing workplace violence for America's largest employers for over 30 years without a single casualty. He'll tell attendees a story of discovery: How helping the food and drug industries cope with the product tampering epidemic of the early 1980s led to the assessment of threatening communications by employees and customers, how this led to the development of comprehensive workplace violence prevention programs, and how this led to the discovery that the causes and solutions for all kinds of misconduct—from the disruptive behavior of those with untreated mental illness to drug use and theft to sexual harassment to bullying to suicide to stalking and cyberstalking to intimate partner violence to workplace threats and violence to radicalization—are so interrelated that they must be managed in an integrated program. You'll learn the importance of developing an early warning system that allows a small, centralized team to investigate, assess, and manage all of these behavior problems at the earliest stage, before toxic employees have a chance to hurt your employees and customers, drain your profits, harm your brand, and drive up your insurance costs. You'll learn things you never knew about hiring, discipline, policies, manager behavior, the vital role of HR, training needs, warning signs, reporting misconduct and unwanted contacts, why common interventions such as restraining orders and police reports commonly backfire, and even how the plaintiffs' bar uses trauma nurses to solicit clients to sue the hospitality industry for negligent security. <https://www.taginc.com/parkdietz/>
